



Laliscia European champion endurance

And 'the flag waving on the flagpole higher than the Meydan FEI European Endurance Championship at Euston Park (UK) due to the company Constance Laliscia, that riding Sacha El Kandhaar won and brought back to Italy a title that was missing from the 18 years. The triumph of the 19 year old rider from Perugia Fuxiateam took shape after a very difficult race, which was attended by 63 pairs representing 20 nations.

Laliscia became the protagonist of a technical masterpiece due to its ability to better manage the strength of the gray gelding than 13 years of F3 Stables, combined with strong tactical sense that the last of the six laps in the program (the race was held on traditional 160 kilometers) away saw it occur decisive nell'allungo which prevented the Spanish Muntala Paula Sanchez, European junior champion in 2016, to return to play for the first place.
