Italian Federation of Equestrian Sports – Italy relaunches its candidacy for the FEI Endurance World Championship with Pisa San Rossore

To keep the next FEI Endurance World Championship 2023 in Italy, the same Organizing Committee took the field, which created the 2021 edition of the event with unanimous approval. – Italia Endurance asd and sistemaeventi.it srl -, proposing any seat, dated April 29, the Pisa San Rossore Hippodrome facility that has also proved to be a true equestrian paradise for this discipline.

The world championship, previously assigned to Isola della Scala – Verona, should have taken place in 2022, just this month, but the International Equestrian Federation (FEI) has unfortunately decided to cancel it a few days after the event due to organizational problems and has consequently the relative candidacies reopened worldwide.

Italia Endurance asd and sistemaeventi.it srl, not positively affected by the incident and strengthened by the recent great success recorded by the 2021 edition in the middle of the Covid-19 pandemic, have decided to take the field again in the name of Italy and the great love for endurance, a sport capable of creating strong relationships and effective promotion for the territory in which it takes place.

The decision was made very quickly, with the full support of the Italian Federation of Equestrian Sports (Fise) and of all local and national institutions all well aware both of the long experience and organizational capacity of the Organizing Committee, and of the extraordinary beauty of the stage offered by Pisa San Rossore.

Gianluca Laliscia CEO & Chairman of sistemaeventi.it srl, states: "With the full sharing of the FISE we felt literally in duty to advance our candidacy and re-propose Italy, Tuscany and therefore Pisa as the world capital of endurance. In a life spent in favor of the development of this sport, I can clearly state, as a rider and at the same time organizer, that there is no better place than Pisa San Rossore to host a world championship: the safety and technicality of our path combine with all the logistic and hospitality qualities offered by an international city like Pisa. I am sure that my thoughts are shared by many". There are already many testimonies of appreciation and support that are coming to the Organizing Committee. Laliscia points this out with evident satisfaction. "I like to remember that among the first we have received that of the President of CONI, Giovanni Malagò. We aim to create an absolutely green and eco-sustainable event as was the case in 2021, with a route already tested, excellent infrastructure, the best technical services, the continued attention to horse welfare, the direction and operation of an expert organizing committee, but above all the enthusiasm to work for an appointment that will celebrate endurance at 360 degrees".
